Further notes on papers from meetings from 1978 to 1981

1978: US premeeting contribution is in 65(*) JCA-11. Meeting papers are numbered 1-36.

1979: US premeeting contribution is in 70(*) JCA-7. Meeting papers are numbered 37-59. There were two resolutions.

1980: Meeting papers are numbered 60-91 and are included in the minutes.

1981: Papers discussed at the meeting appear in X3J3/142 and /143.

Notes:

1. The present WG5 document numbering scheme was started following decisions taken at the 1986 meeting. Numbers N1 to N99 were allocated retrospectively to WG5 documents issued prior to the 1985 meeting and N100 to N199 to documents issued between the 1985 and 1986 meetings. All documents from N1097 onwards, together with some earlier minutes and resolutions, are in the electronic archive. A complete index from N200 onwards is in WG5 Standing Document 1.

2. Full attendance lists are not available for all meetings. In some cases attendance figures have been estimated from voting tallies and/or other reports.

3. The agenda document number is either the preliminary (first draft) or the provisional (second draft). The "provisional" number is used when one was found to exist.

4. It is not known whether there were ad hoc Fortran meetings at the 1964, 1965 or 1967 SC5 meetings, but it is known that SC5 were collaborating with X3.4.3 on Fortran at that time, particularly with regard to production of French and Japanese versions of Fortran 66.
